

ADR for Higher Court Disputes

- The suits pending in the High Court or Appeal Division of the Honorable Supreme Court can be resolved by Alternative Dispute Resolution Process. In such a case, the petitioner needs to apply to the Honorable Supreme Court for its permission.
- The aggrieved person needs to get prior permission from the concerned judicial authority where the case is pending.
- After receiving permission from the High Court or Appeal Division of the Honorable Supreme Court, the suit shall remain suspended until the process of ADR has been finished.
- The Honorable court may suo motu order to resolve the disputed matter through ADR.
